ACCEPTABLE items are: Cardboard, (please cut down the boxes), paper, aluminum cans, and plastic bottles. **UNACCEPTABLE items are:** Styrofoam, household trash, car parts, tv's and electronics.

GOOD WILL accepts electronics at no charge.

COMPUTER HARDWARE will take tv's and electronics for a charge of .45 a lb.
