PLANTING TREES AND SHRUBS

Don't forget to call before you dig—811

Below are a few sections of The Village of Pleasanton Municipal Code concerning trees and shrubs. For full regulations, visit www.pleasantonne.com.

Section 1-608: Spacing of trees

Section 1-609: Distance from curb and sidewalk, depends on tree species size.

Section 1-610: Distance from street corners and fireplugs. No street tree shall be planted closer than 35 feet to any street corner, measured from the point of nearest intersecting curbs or curb lines. No street tree shall be planted closer than 10 feet to any fireplug.

Section 1-611: Utilities, 10' lateral of any overhead utility wire, or within 5' lateral of any underground water, sewer or transmission line or other utility.

Section 1-615: Pruning; Corner Clearance. Prune branches so as not to obstruct the light from any street light or obstruct the view of any street intersection. 8' clearance above street or sidewalk.

The Village of Pleasanton wants everyone aware of the Ordinance pertaining to Article VI— Weeds, Junk Cars, Litter and Dangerous Buildings Regulations. Section 2-602: PUBLIC NUISANCE; GRASSES OR WEEDS states: It is hereby declared to be a public nuisance to permit grasses to grow in excess of 12 inches or to permit weeds of any height to be grown on any property within the corporate limits of the Village. Section 2-603: PUBLIC NUISANCE; LITTER OR DANGEROUS BUILDING states: It is hereby declared to be a public nuisance to permit the accumulation of litter or to maintain a dangerous building on any property within the corporate limits of the Village.

VILLAGE RECYCLE BINS AND DUMPSTER

A reminder on the use of the dumpster and recycle bin the Village provides. There is a limitation on what the Village is allowed to take to the City of Kearney recycle plant.

ACCEPTABLE items are: Cardboard, (please cut down the boxes), paper, aluminum cans, and plastic bottles.

UNACCEPTABLE items are: Styrofoam, household trash, car parts, tv's and electronics.

GOOD WILL accepts electronics at no charge. **NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL!**

Use the convenience of automatic debit to pay your Utility bill. Utility bill will be automatically debited from your bank account on or near the 15th of each month. See authorization form on back.
